

Disaster Appeals Application

A “disaster” is defined as a “sudden occurrence which inflicts widespread catastrophic damage to a large geographic area and/or which generally affects a large number of individuals.” Disaster can be both natural and caused by human conduct. Examples include but are not limited to hurricanes, tornadoes, tidal waves, earthquakes, floods, terrorist acts and explosions. The disaster in question must be declared to be a disaster by a governmental agency, or be determined by the Commission to comply with the definition of disaster provided above.
