Eligibility for CPE credit in a given cycle is based on date of notification of successfully meeting certification or recertification requirements. CPEUs can be awarded for qualifying certifications earned during the current 5-year recertification cycle and up to 6 months before your current recertification cycle. The date of completion of the certification can be either the date of notification of successful completion of the requirements for certification or the date of the examination required for certification. You must complete the certification examination before May 31 of the last year of the recertification cycle. Notification of successful completion of the certification should be received by May 31 of the last year of the recertification cycle, so that you can record the certification on your Step 2: Activity Log before you finish and submit your Activity Log on May 31 to CDR for review.
